Dear Ms. Jansch:

After serving your E.R. 1.15 Notice ("Notice:"), I wrote you acknowledging that the law related to FEHBA has changed, and that it was likely we would be able to reach an agreement. In addition, we advised that your Notice was deficient in that it did not include the name of the tortfeasor or the tortfeasor's insurer, which we requested you provide. You neither acknowledged HonorHealth's willingness to work with you nor provided the information that is required pursuant to the rule. In fact, we never heard back from you at all.

Based on the date of your letter, you stated you intended to disburse the settlement proceeds in 90 days, on or about August 9, 2016. Please advise if you have done so or if those proceeds are currently maintained in your trust account. In addition, please provide the name of the tortfeasor's insurer without delay. Your prompt response will allow HonorHealth to consider its legal options pursuant to A.R.S. § 33-934.
